



Mini Alpaca Trek (only for families with children age 5-6)

Come and visit our beautiful Alpacas. Our 'Mini Alpaca Trek' is especially designed for children between 5 and 6 years of age and their family, as they are unable to do the full Alpaca Trek.

The day begins with a quick health and safety chat and guidance in holding and leading your alpaca. We'll also provide fascinating facts on what makes alpacas so unique, calming and loveable. You will be asked to sign a waiver form before the trek can start.

The only difference from the main Alpaca Trek, is that it will be a shorter distance and on a flat field with limited alpacas per walk. (Alpacas are social animals so minimum of two Alpacas must be booked)

It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to keep their child safe and abide by the rules of the 'health and safety' and 'terms and conditions' provided, at all times.

We offer free self service tea and coffee and you are welcome to bring a picnic with you to eat in our picnic area, where you will be able to watch the Alpacas in the field while you eat.

Everything is out doors, so please bring suitable footwear and clothing in case the weather is cooler/wet. (**no** open toe footwear allowed)

1 Alpaca to 1 Adult - £18.00

1 Alpaca to 1 Adult and 1 Child - £25.00

1 Alpaca to 2 Adults - £33.00

Spectators - £15.00 (no children spectators sorry)
